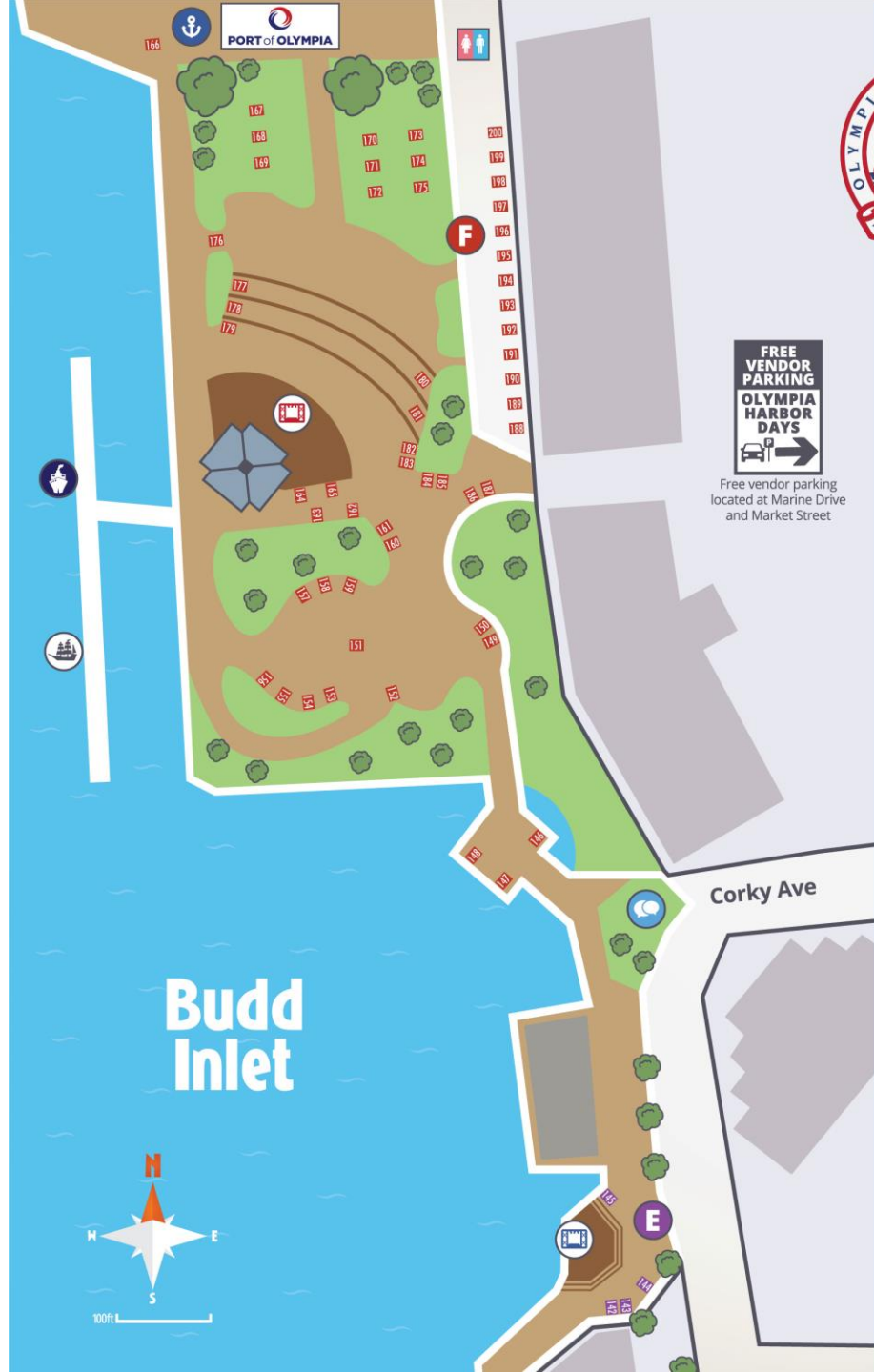
WHAT IS HARBOR DAYS?

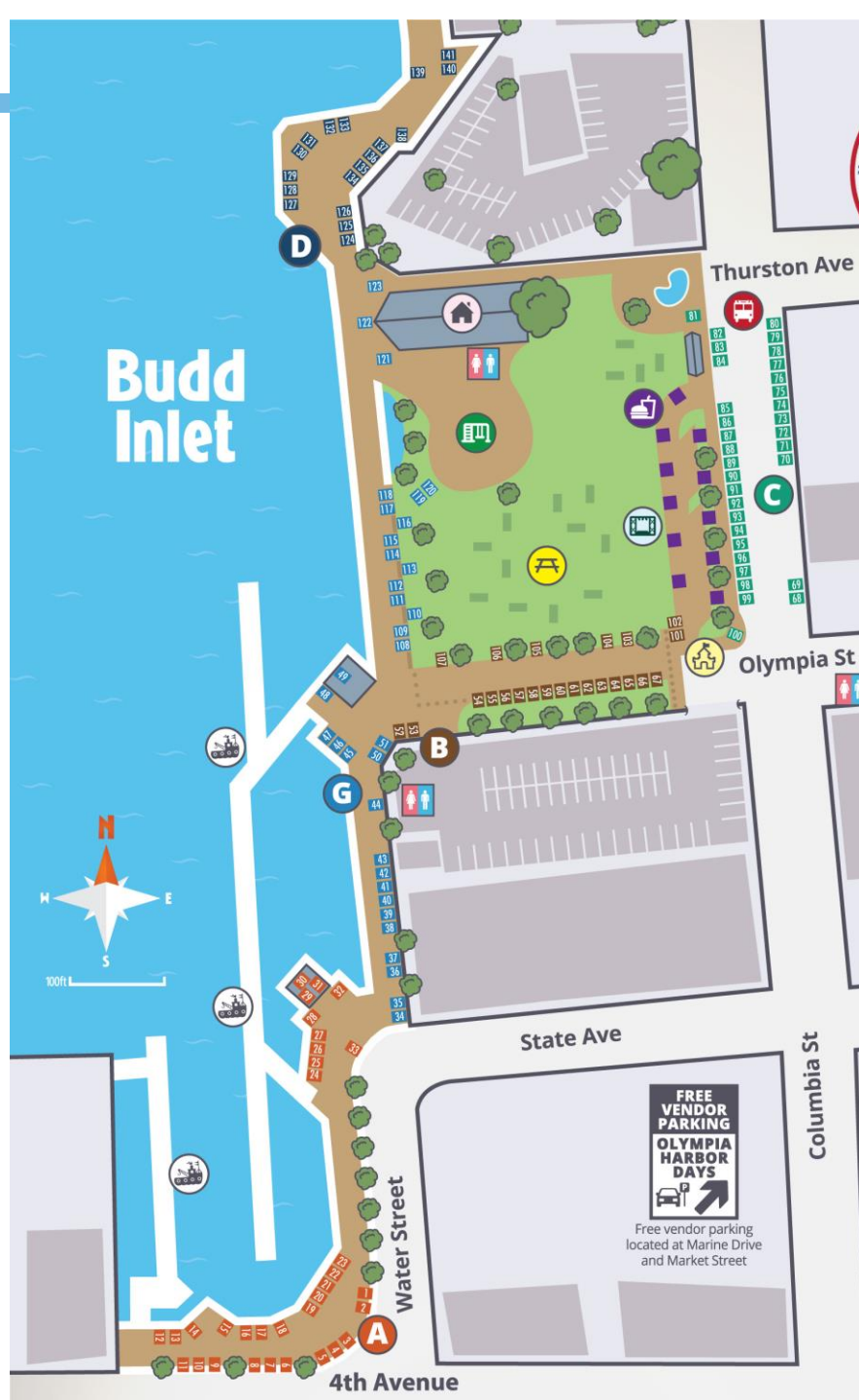
OUR PLAN

- The goal is to promote all the fleets in the Pacific Northwest growing our fleets




